- Theses of report (requirements to content and formatting are attached);
- Propositions to project of recommendations of Internet-conference.

Requirements to formatting of materials. Materials should be presented as theses (up to 4 pages) in MS Word, font type – Times New Roman; font size – 13 pt; intervals between lines – 1,5 line; margins: top – 2 cm, bottom – 2cm, left – 3 cm, right – 1,5 cm; Ukrainian language (for foreign participants – Russian or English). In the upper right corner should be presented information about its author in Ukrainian (last name, first name, middle name, academic degree and title, full name of place of employment and position, postal address, contact phone-number), number and title of a Part. Below in the middle should be put title of theses of report, main text and bibliography. References in the text are obligatory.

**Bibliography** should be presented in alphabetical order below the main text. Bibliographical description should be made according to national Ukrainian standards.

Theses of reports will be published without additional editing.

## **Requirements to electronic version of report:**

- In the title last and first names of a participant;
- MS Word 2003 file in doc-format.

All the expenses that are connected with Internet-conference (accommodation, transportation costs etc.) are paid by participants on their own.
