MASTER OF SCIENCE IN NURSING PROGRAM

MS in Nursing programs were first introduced in Ukraine in 2008. The MSN degree for RNs expands their knowledge and skills needed for the roles of nursing administror, clinical nurse leader, nurse practitioner and clinical nurse educator.

BSN to MSN program is evidence-based and developed in accordance with the Essentials of Baccalaureate Education for Professional Nursing Practice from the Accreditation Commission of Ukrainian Ministry of Education and Sciences.

After completion of the program, graduates are prepared for doctoral level education. A core of nursing disciplines together with electives allow students to tailor their studies to their desired career path, whether it is as educators, leaders, or advanced practice nurses.




