√ The University is comprised of the following structural units: Faculty of Medicine; Faculty of Pharmacy; Faculty of Dentistry; International Students' Faculty: Institute of Medical and Biological Problems; Institute of Modelling and Analysis of Pathological Processes; Institute of Morphology; Institute of Pharmacology, Medical Biochemistry and Hygiene; Institute of Nursing; and Institute of Postgraduate education.

√ 93 % of university faculty have an academic degree; this is the highest number
among all medical schools of Ukraine.

√ Most of the TNMU teachers give lectures and practical classes in English, 40 % of them have international certificates of English at the B2 level.

√ TNMU implements modern learning technologies: independent student testing, remote evaluation using Moodle e-learning platform, practical skills matrices, and objective, structured clinical exam.

√ TNMU is the leader among universities in Ukraine by the number of winners in student olympiads in educational disciplines.

√ The University initiated a double diploma program (Ukrainian and European)
for students enrolled to the Institute of Nursing Bachelor and Master Degree
programs.

√ TNMU operates a multidisciplinary University Hospital; the university has launched an interdepartmental simulation training center; it supervises five teaching and practice centers of primary medical and sanitary care, and a Dentistry Clinic at the University Hospital.

√ TNMU faculty and staff work at its 57 academic and clinical Departments. Among the faculty are a full member of National Academy of Medical Sciences, two corresponding members of NAMS, and numerous recipients of National and Presidential prizes and awards of distinction in teaching and research.











ACADEMICS

leading medical school in Ukraine, TNMU utilizes a traditional multidisciplinary approach to higher education. The academic process adopts European and World qualification requirements for the specialists in the fields of medicine, dentistry, pharmacy, and nursing.

In 2017 TNMU was awarded international certificate of ISO 9001:2015 standard of Quality management systems.

Today, the University employs more than 600 highly accomplished professors and enrolls more than 6,000 full-time and distance students (over 4,000 domestic and about 2,000 international). The teaching is done in Ukrainian and English.

TSMU carries out training for 55 licensed and accredited specialties. 15 of these specialties are taught at the undergraduate level and 40 at the graduate level.

TNMU clinical Departments are located in 18 affiliated regional and municipal medical institutions. Applicants with completed secondary education are invited to enroll for the following programs of study:

University campus has seven academic buildings, including large interdepartmental simulation training center where students can perfect their practical skills on medical manikins and in simulated clinical setting. The students have the opportunity to train not only in Ukrainian clinics, but also abroad, including in Poland and Turkey.

TNMU operates three teaching museums: at the Department of Medical Biology, Department of Human Anatomy and Department of Pathological Anatomy and Forensic Medicine.

Within the walls of the university there is a Preparatory Department, where students from different countries of the world deepen their knowledge of chemistry, biology, physics, study Ukrainian language and culture.















CLINICAL AND PREVENTIVE WORK

he University has a wealth of experience in training medical personnel.

TNMU faculty and staff perform medical duties in 33 clinical departments of 19 regional and municipal medical institutions of

Ternopil region and in the cities of Rivne and Zhytomyr with the total of 4,800 medical beds. Among more than 350 TNMU academic staff working at the clinical Departments are more than 60 full professors, about 200 associate professors, and over 130 assistant professors. The University operates a Dentistry Clinic at the University Hospital and a mobile Clinic on Wheels. TNMU has established a system of teaching and practice centers for primary health care in rural areas.





INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION

NMU works with 76 foreign partners from 31 countries of the world: USA, Canada, Argentina, Sweden, Syria, Malaysia, Kingdom of Morocco, Egypt, Turkey, France, Poland, Germany, Czech Republic, Hungary, Slovak Republic, Austria, Republic of Kosovo, Georgia, Tajikistan, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Republic of Belarus, Belgium, the Hellenic Republic, Switzerland, the Estonian Republic, the Latvian Republic, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Moldova, China and Malta. These partnerships create a network of joint academic, professional and research projects.

TNMU is a participant on a number of international programs: Erasmus+, Erasmus Mundus Medea, PolBuCan, Mevlana, Horizon 2020, and Cross-border Cooperation Program Poland-Belarus-Ukraine 2014–2020.

The University is a member of the European University Association, Baltic University Program, and has become a signatory to Magna Charta Universitatim.

TNMU successfully collaborates with international organizations, such as the World Health Organization (WHO), United Nations Educational

Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG), The Foundation for the Advancement of International Medical Education and Research (Distance Learning (FAIMER), Association for the International Exchange of Students in Economics and Commerce (AIESEC), Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst (DAAD), and European Resuscitation Council.

Implementing the Visiting Professor program, TNMU consistently invites leading international scholars to give lectures and workshops to its students and academic staff.

In recent years the University has been placing a special emphasis on developing a program of international professional internships.

Each summer, TNMU holds a unique the International Student Summer Camp, aimed at bringing young people together and connecting medical school students from Ukraine and abroad. The Summer Camp offers professional trainings, sports competitions and performing arts work-











UNIVERSITY

he University has a modern research library for the needs of its professors, postgraduates and students. They can check out study and research literature, study in the reading room, use internet class, journal department, information and bibliographic department, and a meeting space for holding roundtables, discussions, and presentations.

The library collection currently holds about 400 thousand documents, representing a wide range of scientific, educational, artistic, and reference literature.

Library visitors have free access to databases such as HINARI, BioMed Central, PubMed, Blackwell, Wolters Kluwer International Health and Science, Springer Verlag, and John Wiley, allowing them to access publications in more than 3,000 professional national and international journals.







STUDENT LIFE

he University is a nexus for personal development of its students, a place for meetings and communication. The creative team of TNMU, ArtDrama Theater Studio, Game Club, standup team, One by One rock band, student and teacher choir, Chervona Kalyna dance group and other performing arts and music ensembles are active at university. An artistic student team publishes a glossy quarterly Unitime.

Students have excellent access to excellent athletic and sports facilities. Many of them participate in team sports: basketball, volleyball, athletics, kickboxing, tennis, and gymnastics.

TNMU is proud of its strong volunteer movement. Students visits to care facilities, organize and carry out a variety of public awareness campaigns, charity actions and drives to help disadvantaged groups.

Students have affordable recreation and relaxation options in town Chervona Kalyna Academic and Recreation Complex. Located in a unique forest setting, this facility boasts a garden, arboretum, petting zoo, open-air pool and courts, and physical therapy services.





FACULTY OF MEDICINE

s one of the oldest structural units of the University, the Faculty of Medicine has rich traditions. The Faculty comprises four academic and research institutes, and 38 departments where students undergo theoretical study and general medical practical training. Close to 3,000 students are currently enrolled at the Faculty. Since its inception, more than twenty thousand graduates of the Faculty earned their Doctor of Medicine degrees.







FACULTY OF PHARMACY

he Faculty of Pharmacy includes five academic departments. Today, it enrolls more than 1,000 students. The Faculty manages a number of facilities essential for training of competitive specialists, such as botanical garden, Teaching Pharmacy, modern study rooms and research laboratories. Over the years, it graduated close to 3,500 specialists (pharmacists, clinical pharmacists, and cosmetologists) for work in modern-day pharmaceutical industry.



FACULTY OF DENTISTRY

he Faculty of Dentistry includes four academic departments, and enrolls about 1,000 students. It operates Dentistry Clinic at the University Hospital, where upperclassmen can develop their practical skills. Faculty's academic program emphasizes hands-on experience, thus its students have every opportunity to deliver counseling and medical assistance to the patients of clinical departments affiliated with the Faculty. To date, more than 1,000 dentists have been awarded their degrees.





INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS' FACULTY

he International Students' Faculty enrolls more than 2,000 from about 60 countries.

Among its most prominent national societies are the associations of students from India, Nigeria, Ghana and Poland. Faculty-run preparatory program trains its graduates to enroll to any medical university in Ukraine. To date, the Faculty has awarded close to 2,500 Doctor of Medicine degrees.



ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF POSTGRADUATE EDUCATION

he Institute of Postgraduate Education includes General Treatment, Pediatrics, Surgery, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pharmacy, Dentistry Departments. Today, the institute offers medical residency in close to 20 specialties, and continuous education for doctors in General practice and Family medicine; Urgent Care; Health Care Organization and Management; Clinical Laboratory Diagnostics, and Pharmacy Management. Pre-certification training courses at the Institute of Postgraduate Education cover 19 specialties, while 23 professional improvement courses for doctors are offered in 15 academic and clinical fields. More than 42 thousand doctors and about 10 thousand residents have improved their medical skills and qualifications at the Institute.



ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH INSTITUTE OF NURSING

he Institute of Nursing offers training to health care professionals towards Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Nursing and Paramedic. It was the first among Ukrainian schools to introduce distance learning, building on the modern internet technology and experience of countries that have been using this form of learning to train nursing staff. The Institute trains domestic and international students from the USA, Canada, Israel, Nigeria, Ghana, Zimbabwe and countries of Europe. In its 20 years of work the Institute of Nursing trained close to 4 thousand people.





UKRAINE

kraine is a country in the south-eastern part of Europe with the total area of 603,628 km², or 5.7 % of the territory of Europe and 0.44 % of the world. The population of Ukraine is over 48 million. The capital city Kyiv is one of the oldest cities in Europe. The official language is Ukrainian. Most of the population follows Christian faith, primarily of the Eastern denominations such as Orthodox and Greek Catholic. Among other sizable communities of faithful are Roman Catholics, Protestantism and Muslims.

Ukraine is a major tourism destination. The most popular among the travelers are the Black Sea coast, Podillia and Volyn, the clities of Kyiv, Odesa and Lviv. The country's special pride is its natural reserves, totaling about 6 thousand sites. The most notable among them are the Carpathian National Nature Park, Shatsky National Natural Park, and National Nature Park Synevir. Ukraine boasts 200 thousand natural, history, architecture and art monuments, as well as 378 museums.



TERNOPIL

he city of Ternopil in western Ukraine is the business, cultural and spiritual center of Ternopil region. The 7,268 hectare city is a home to the population of about 200 thousand people. A temperate continental of the region is characterized by warm humid summers and cold winters.

The main attraction of Ternopil is a large central lake with an area of 400 hectares. Ternopil parks surprise with their beauty throughout the seasons. These green spaces in the middle of the city invite visitors to relax and recharge both body and soul. Another prominent sight the Old Castle, built around the time of Ternopil founding in 1540. Close to 20 fountains dot the city, bringing together its diverse architectural styles.

Ternopil is a nexus of various art, music and food festivals and performances. Drama and pupper theaters, a music hall, natural history museum, restaurants and cafes, art galleries, and performing art spaces all add up to the atmosphere of coziness and comfort.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1. Candidates wishing to apply to TNMU please send an email to the International Students Office at deans office@tdmu.edu.ua with:
 - J copy of international passport:
 - √ copy of High (Secondary) School Certificate with transcript;
 - J consent to processing of personal data:
 - J preparatory course certificate (if available);
 - J results of external independent testing (if available).
- 2. After receiving the document package we will send you detailed instructions. When you complete them, we will send you an official Invitation Letter for studying at TNMU to your correspondence address by a courier express mail. The Invitation Letter should be submitted to the Embassy of Ukraine in your country to receive a student visa.
- After obtaining the student visa you must inform the International Students Office of TNMU about the exact date of your arrival to Ukraine and your flight number.
- Upon your arrival at Ternopil National Medical University you should submit the Application Pack to the International Students Office; you will then be invited for an interview.

Application Package (to be submitted to the International Students Office personally):

- J passport with a valid student visa;
- √high (secondary) school certificate with transcript (original and copy);
- /birth certificate (original and copy):
- √ health certificate (valid within two months from the moment of issue);
- √HIV-negative test certificate (valid within two months from the moment of issue);
- √12 photos.

The admission procedure will be completed after you sign an Agreement with the University and pay your tuition fee for the 1st year of study.
